Kana Directory	<p>The Kana Directory is a digital, searchable directory of data related to project developers and nature codes, as it pertains to existing UK Nature Carbon projects. The Directory curates and organises projects in a way that makes the data to support investment into UK Nature Carbon projects easily accessible, and enables developers to showcase themselves and their project portfolios.</p> <p>The Directory (public portal) allows “Public Users” to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Search nature-based carbon projects using filters, sorts and specific parameters including by country, code, project type, badge / certification or number of units.- View the individual project listings.- Download project documentation.- Register interest with project developers.- View developer showcase pages.- View Validation/Verification body (“VVB”) showcase pages.- View Code showcase pages.- View the Kana Badge and Certificate showcase pages, which are additional quality assurance the project has voluntarily pursued.- View the Code comparison.- View the Project Type description pages. <p>A Public User is a member of the public without a user account.</p> <p>The Directory (public portal) is free to use.</p> <p>The Directory (developer portal) allows “Developer Users” to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Access their project listings.- Add/remove project imagery.- Add/remove project videos.- Add/edit/remove project long and short descriptions.- Add/edit/remove project marketing settings:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Project visibility; - Unit sale and price ; - Enabled/disable public interest emails; - Redirect public interest emails. <p>It is not possible to purchase or sell units via the Directory. Any sales or purchases of units must be through a registry approved by the relevant Applicable Code</p> <p>A Developer User is the individual or company who represents a project/group through the validation/verification process or in the applicable Registry. The project developer could be the land owner, a third party representing the landowner, or the group manager.</p> <p>The Directory (developer portal) is free to use.</p> <p>For the avoidance of doubt, uploading Developer content to the Directory does not constitute registration of a Project under or in accordance with any Applicable Code.</p>
Hub	<p>The Kana Hub enables UK Nature Carbon project development through digital processing, enabling project developers to complete Code-specific documentation using digital workflows.</p> <p>The Hub is also a digital venue that connects carbon market buyers and sellers allowing developers and suppliers to reach a wider pool of corporate buyers and institutional investors. The Kana Hub and the data democratisation it provides is a critical and evolving component in the ongoing effort to protect our shared environment.</p> <p>An active Kana Developer User account is required for any entity wishing to manage projects or use the digital workflows. All account applicants will be subject to Kana Terms of Service. New developers can contact us to use the Directory.</p> <p>The Hub (developer portal) allows Developer Users to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Create and complete project activities (Code-specific workflows) using the Kana components; - Upload/attach evidence and documents to the project activity; - Track progress of the project activity. - View the audit history of the project activity and the audit history of its associated documents - Generate the project activity output. - Grant access (including extend or revoke) to one of your projects to another developer, with either read or write permissions. - Apply for a badge or certificate.

- Add/edit users to the organisation's account.

There are 3 roles for a Developer User, providing different permissions:

- Owner - provides full access to Developer Account
- Administrator - provides full access to Developer Account
- Staff - provides access limited to:
 - Accepting project access grants.
 - Creating / managing organisation users.

The Hub (developer portal) is free to use.

For the avoidance of doubt, uploading Developer content to the Hub does not constitute registration of a Project under or in accordance with any Applicable Code.
